The Madheshi Woman: August 18, 2025

Dear GNN faithful,

There are times that Third World problems seem too impossible to solve. So, the following true story is an example of how God intervenes.

There's a problem in Nepal. The best example I could think of is of the Samaritan people in the Bible. They were a mixed group, part Jew and part other cultures. They were despised by many Jews. Well ok, take this example of a people problem and bring it to our times today. In Nepal there are a people called Madheshi (Samaritans), who live in the Terai regions of Nepal. This region is along the south border of Nepal and India, mainly flat country, not mountainous as you would think of Nepal. Madheshi people are a India/Nepalese mix not fitting into either culture. Sound familiar?

Nepalgunj, where our GNN Headquarters is located, is in this region, 4 miles from the India border. Thus, there are many Madheshi people. GNN has a group 5 minutes from our office. They are very poor, and have built stick and tarp homes along the road on government land. They have no toilets or running water.

But the women of GNN made a mission of bringing the Gospel to these dear people. Our women are educated in various methods of evangelism, such as the Evange Cube, the SING program and of course our GNN tract. Several women accepted Jesus into their lives and began to attend the GNN church located close to them at the training center. One of the women was pregnant for her first baby but was very scared because it was in a breech position, feet first. She would normally have the baby right in the slum house! But GNN has an emergency health fund called the "Madhu" fund. Our women made arrangements with the hospital through our program leader, Deepak Singh, and doctors were prepared for a patient with a breech condition in advance. Because the women could not enter the hospital without paying first, they knew the delivery would be paid in full by GNN.

Finally last week the time arrived! Mom was so afraid that her baby would die. But our GNN women took her to the hospital. So many people around the world were praying. Suddenly the doctor came out, announcing that at the last minute the baby turned! No c-section, just a very smooth wonderful birth. Mom and baby girl were elated and thanking God for answered prayer!

Since then, dad has accepted Jesus, and also dad's good friend. The good friend lives about 20 kilometers east of Nepalgunj. "Please come to my village" the man pleaded. So days later Philip, Susila and others took a mission trip to

this village, having to cross one river by bridge and a stream by using our Bolero (Jeep). To make this story short I can tell you that so far 15 people have come to Jesus from this other village, and the team is not home yet! All because of the women of GNN listening to God and GOING! What a privilege to serve Almighty GOD. When God calls, please do not say no.
