Inspiring Testimony of P. Tulka BK: July 28, 2025



Inspiring testimony of P. Tulka b.k

Praise the Lord! All glory and thanks to our Lord Jesus Christ.

Today, I want to share a very special and beautiful testimony — the inspiring journey of Pastor Tulka B.K., a woman from a remote village who had no opportunity to attend school as a child but later learned to read and write through basic adult education.

Pastor Tulka B.K. was married at a young age and faced tremendous challenges in life. Carrying the burden of her family responsibilities, she followed the ancestral traditions of worshiping idols and deities. But instead of bringing peace, these practices led to greater turmoil in her life. Her life was filled with unrest and suffering, both spiritually and physically. She struggled with health issues, especially a severe case of piles, which weakened her physically and emotionally.

Eventually, she traveled to Nepalganj for medical treatment. During this time, she stayed with relatives who were believers in the Lord Jesus Christ. They shared the Gospel with her. At first, she did not accept the message. However, one day while being tormented by evil spirits, Pastor Hiralal prayed for her. Through that prayer, the demonic oppression left her completely — and she was delivered and set free in Jesus' name!

That day, she received Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. After completing three months of medical treatment, she returned to Humla, renewed and strengthened, and began to serve the Lord with great passion and boldness. Filled with the power of the Holy Spirit, she began to share the Gospel and lead others toward Christ.

Later, she was invited to Nepalganj to attend one-month training under the Story in Grace Project. After completing the training, she returned home and faithfully continued her ministry, proclaiming the Good News and nurturing new believers.

As a result of her efforts, she helped send a local brother, Jaidhan Sunar, from Tajakot Rural Municipality, for six month training. Today, he too is actively serving and leading fellowships in his village.

Now, Pastor Tulka B.K. is leading a vibrant fellowship in one of the most remote and spiritually dark areas — Rahadev village in Sarkegad Rural Municipality, Humla. This fellowship is growing spiritually, and the number of believers is steadily increasing.



For a woman, especially in such a remote region, to carry out this mission is incredibly challenging — but God has been using His daughter in mighty and miraculous ways. Through her, many are coming to know the Lord Jesus Christ day by day.
